CURRICULUM UPDATE

The NSW Student learning library is a suite of learning resources which are accessible for teachers, parents and carers, and students to be used in class or at home.

The resources are aligned with new syllabuses and have been quality assured by educational professionals within the department. The new resources will supplement and complement other resources being provided by the department, including units developed by department curriculum experts to support the roll-out of new syllabuses.






The P&C want to give a huge shoutout to all the amazing parents who made the election day cake stall and BBQ event such a success!

MHPS NEW FINANCE SYSTEM

We are excited to announce our school has transitioned to an upgraded School Bytes finance system.

What is the School Bytes portal?

The School Bytes portal provides flexibility for you to conveniently:

- Make school payments online (including paying for multiple siblings at once)
- Use a family credit to pay for an activity or school contributions
- Download a receipt for payments made
- View all historical payments in one place
- Complete and submit digital permission notes
- View the status of all permission notes
- Request a refund if required

This can be done where you want at any time: day or night.

Through the portal, you will easily be able to download a receipt once a payment has been made and have access to view all historical payments when needed. Online payments are processed in real-time and can be viewed by school staff immediately. While our preference is for payments to be made via the portal, we will still accept payment via cash, cheque, money order and EFTPOS.

BACK TO SCHOOL NSW PROGRAM

You can now apply for the Premier's Back to School NSW program, offering \$150 worth of vouchers (3 x \$50 vouchers) to help pay for school supplies like school uniforms, shoes, bags, textbooks and stationery

Every primary and secondary school student in NSW is eligible for the vouchers.

You can apply for and access your vouchers in your MyServiceNSW account, in the Service NSW app, by calling Service NSW on 137788 or by visiting your local Service CentreExternal link.

To be eligible, your child needs to be a NSW resident and enrolled in a NSW primary or secondary school in 2023.

The MHPS Office is able to accept the Back to School vouchers for excursions. Please come in to the Office to use your voucher.

The MHPS Uniform Shop is able to accept the Back to School vouchers. Please come in (Tuesday 8.45-9.15am and Friday 8.45-9.15am) to use your voucher. We regret that the vouchers cannot be used for online purchases.




