

DEPUTY PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE



Parents/carers of children from Kindergarten to Year 12 must ensure that their children attend school every day. On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons may include:

- being sick or having and infectious disease
- having an unavoidable medical appointment
- being required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g., attending a funeral.

Parent/carers must provide an explanation for absences to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence.

Where an explanation has not been received within the 7-day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unexplained on the student's record. Students away for three or more days should provide a medical certificate. If a child tests positive for COVID-19 please send the school the ServiceNSW confirmation of the record of the COVID result.

MENSTRUAL HYGIENE PROGRAM COMES TO MHPS

The NSW Department of Education has introduced a menstrual hygiene program in NSW public schools.

Our menstrual hygiene program aims to reduce any barriers that may prevent students from participating fully in school life. Menstruation (and its unpredictability) may stop students from attending school or taking part in learning activities. There are also known health risks from using improvised sanitary hygiene products.

As part of the program, our school now has dispensers that provide free pads and tampons for students to access during school hours. Period underwear is also available.

Our school can also order period underwear at no cost for students. Students can access this product by emailing the office on middleharb-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au

Each pack of period undies contains 2 pairs that are the same size, colour and style. These are available upon request and there may be a short waiting period until the undies are delivered to our school.
